
Also the Bar and the Kitchen did an excellent job serving the thirsty and hungry Patrons.





# Neerlandia

In the previous RDC magazine we published part 1 of an amusing article about 5 stereotypes of the Dutch. Please find following part 2 – and the article may have a little surprise for you!

## ***Bikes***

Ahh yes, the bicycle is another cliché about the Dutch. Although not invented by the Dutch (in fact, it was German inventor Karl Drais who invented the precursor to the modern bicycle in 1817), the two-wheeled mode of transport is a hallmark of the Netherlands. Perhaps it's because it's so small and flat and therefore relatively easy to manoeuvre with two pedals. Or, perhaps it's because bicycles save space and are environmentally friendly. It's all, of course, complete conjecture. But the point is, if you want to fit into Dutch life, you should probably get a bicycle.

What is quickly becoming noticeable, though, about this cliché is that bikes are modernising, and fast. Although you will still see many of the clunky, heavy, back-pedal brake models that you would associate with being Dutch, do not be surprised when you are overtaken by a silent, sleek-looking bike with a not-so-new looking owner. Electric bikes are rapidly becoming more popular, and more difficult to distinguish from regular bikes.

This can be a good thing if it is making exercise and freedom more accessible for those who are less mobile. It also means that older generations are suddenly much speedier than they're used to, so keep your wits about you!



I hope to be able to greet some new members in the new year.



# German Christmas Traditions

1. Children open **Stockings** on the 6 of December (**Nikolaus Day**). Often instead of stockings, children put an empty boot out on the evening of the 5 and if they have been good throughout the year, Nikolaus will have filled their boot with sweets, oranges and nuts by the morning of the 6.
2. Christmas is traditionally celebrated on **Christmas Eve** ("**Heiliger Abend**" - evening of the 24 of December). Many households will spend the day decorating the tree, preparing food for the family and sprucing up the home. At night, everybody will gather around the tree.

According to tradition, the '**Christkind**' (Christ child) delivers the presents when the children are waiting outside the room. A bell will be rung for children to step inside the room, where the family will then sing carols before the **Bescherung** (**opening of gifts**) begins. Dinner is usually served before the Bescherung, and many families head to Christmas Eve services at their local churches before or after the Bescherung.

3. The (**usually real**) **Christmas Tree** is put up and decorated on Christmas Day, not any time beforehand!
4. **Advent wreaths**, known as an **Adventskranz**, is a tradition which the German Lutherans in the 16 century kick-started. Typically, the wreath consists of four candles in a bed of pine cones, berries, dried flowers and various festive ornaments. Most households will bring out the wreath at the beginning of December, lighting one candle each Sunday throughout the month until Christmas Day.
