


we moved on to Japan with more special treats. The final reveal caused an enormous shriek as

going through, but also the realisation that despite all the troubles in our world, humanity love and kindness was on display right here. And perhaps,


a few of those present relived a personal experience in their own lives, which was in some way, not too dissimilar to that of Fleur and her family.







Our teams did well, Caity Worth, Arvin Nair and Jake Worth winning the 10m Junior Air teams' event and Jo Muir joining Katie and Siobhy Nicholls to win both the 25m Pistol and 10m Women's Air events. Siobhy Nicholls and Mike Giustiniano won the Women's and Men's Aggregate trophies. Siobhy and Katie also travelled to Brisbane to compete at the BISC Cup a national team selection event, both making finals in their events with Siobhy winning Bronze in the 25m Pistol event.

Glühwein (German Mulled Wine) Recipe

1 Orange, cut into slices

Juice of 1 Orange

2 Cinnamon sticks

4 Star Anise

6 Cloves, whole

4 cardamom pods

50 grams Sugar (or some honey)

1 litre Red wine


Put all ingredients in a pot and slowly bring up the temparature to just before simmering. **DO NOT**
