Renovation Update



Kitchen

On 13 November 2023 we officially started with our major kitchen renovation.

After the demolition of the old kitchen, we cut the concrete floor and installed new drainage and water pipes. A new entry door was cut into the hallway wall and the old hallway walls and doors were removed. Beams were installed to support the new ceiling. The back wall was lined with plaster board and a new wall was constructed.

The next steps include installation of the new rangehood and completing electrical and plumbing installations.

The new cool room installation has been scheduled for the end of January.

Due to many factors the renovation process will take longer than planned. At this stage we are aiming for the end of February, but it may take up to the end of March.

<u>Wurstbude</u>

A nice new stainless steel backdrop was installed and a new Bain Marie was purchased and installed during Oktoberfest. The Club also purchased a new fridge and freezer unit to comply with Food Safety Regulations.

Snooker Room

The very old electrical switchboard in the room was relocated to the new Undercroft Storage. The removal and relocation of this switchboard was another desperate upgrade of our facilities and made space for the continued renovations of the Snooker Room.

Thanks to the help of Frosty from the WA Brick Society we could secure new glass sliding doors. We hope to upgrade the Snooker Room door with them.



Edelweiss bar Cool Room

The upgrade works in the Cool Room are now completed and we are very happy with the results. It has made a huge difference in there. Special Thanks to our Kellermeister David Vieceli who emptied and restocked the Cool Room and worked hard to get the beer flowing again.

We also relocated the beer chiller to the new Undercroft Storage.

The new refrigeration unit is located on the roof now and we removed the noisy old unit from the undercroft area.

These small steps are paving the way to a brighter, cleaner and more inclusive undercroft area which we are working on.



Thank you for allowing the committee to apply for a loan of \$100,000 towards the renovation of the RDC kitchen. After many months of negotiation and hard work by our treasurer, Martin Engel, this has finally been approved by the ANZ.

Meanwhile everything has become more expensive.

At the last members' meeting, there were some of you who expressed a desire to either donate or lend some money to the RDC to further help with the many urgent projects that are vital to the continued successful running of the Club.

Recently an Energy Efficiency Grant from the Department of Industry, Science and Resources was obtained to renovate the cool room in the Edelweißbar, which is of some help. There are, however, many other repairs and improvements the committee would like to make. For example:

- Replacement of the air-conditioning/heating throughout the entire building. *
- 2. Introduction of a POS system for the bars and the restaurant.
- 3. Replacement of both dance floors and refurbishment of the Sports Hall floor.
- 4. Completion of the new storeroom in the undercroft.
- 5. Completion of the Karl's Bar renovations.
- 6. Completion of the Snooker Room renovations.
- * Annette, our Admin, has submitted a grant request for this very expensive undertaking and is looking into more grant options.
