Wolfgang hat viel für den Club geleistet. Er war von 1967 bis 1969 Präsident. Er hat die Lufthansa als Sponsor in den Club geholt. In München hat er sich mit einer Brauerei in Verbindung gesetzt, als er Deutschland besuchte, und hat die Möbel in der Edelweißhalle unentgeltlich plus Versand nach Australien geliefert bekommen.

Er war jahrelang Radiomoderator unseres Radiosender; er gründete die Skat Gruppe. Da er begeisterter Schach Spieler ist, organisierte er viele Schachwettbewerbe im Club. Das ist nur einiges, was er für den Club geleistet hat.

For years he was the announcer for our radio program; he founded the Skat Group and because he is a passionate chess player, he organised many a chess competition in the Club. And that is only an example of all that he achieved for us.

We wish Wolfgang all the best for the future and hope to welcome him and his wife to our Christmas Party.

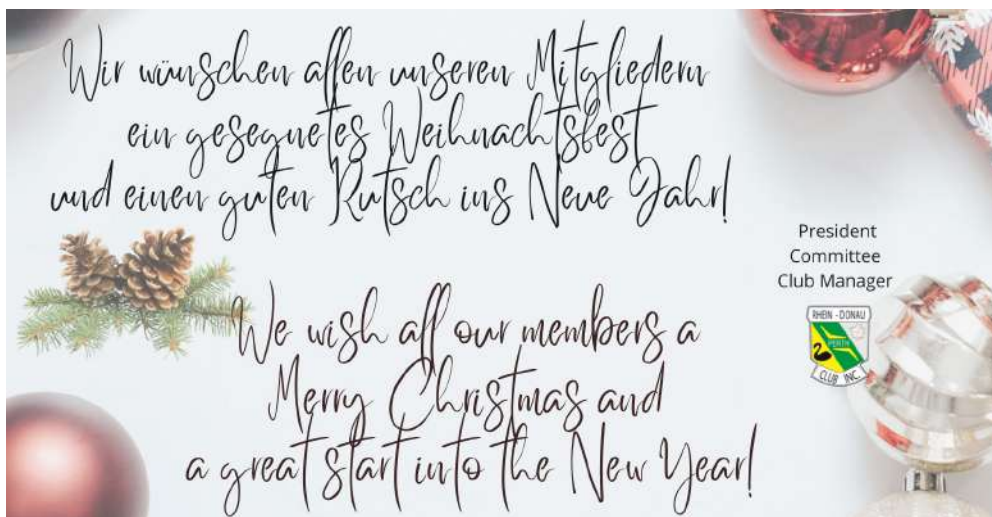
Club Closure over Christmas and New Year

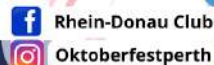

We will then start to be able to invite visitors to the clubroom.

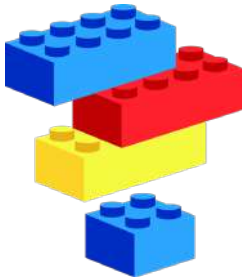

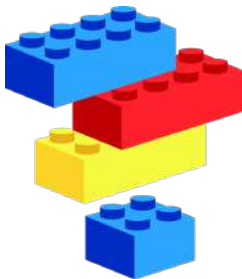

Dear Members

Thank you for allowing the committee to apply for a loan of \$100,000 towards the renovation of the RDC kitchen. After many months of negotiation and hard work by our treasurer, Martin Engel, this has finally been approved by the ANZ.

Meanwhile everything has become more expensive.

At the last members' meeting, there were some of you who expressed a desire to either donate or lend some money to the RDC to further help with the many urgent projects that are vital to the continued successful running of the Club.

Recently an Energy Efficiency Grant from the Department of Industry, Science and Resources was obtained to renovate the cool room in the Edelweißbar, which is of some help. There are, however, many other repairs and improvements the committee would like to make. For example:

1. Replacement of the air-conditioning/heating throughout the entire building. *
2. Introduction of a POS system for the bars and the restaurant.
3. Replacement of both dance floors and refurbishment of the Sports Hall floor.
4. Completion of the new storeroom in the undercroft.
5. Completion of the Karl's Bar renovations.
6. Completion of the Snooker Room renovations.

* Annette, our Admin, has submitted a grant request for this very expensive undertaking and is looking into more grant options.
