Irmgard Birtwistle

7 December 1927 - 16 Dec 2024



Irmgard (Irmi)Tscheschlog was born in Munich on 7 December 1927.

Together with her parents, Paul and Anna, and her sister Berta, Irmi emigrated to Perth in 1953.

In July 1954, Irmi married Joe Birtwistle, whom she had previously met in Munich whilst he was travelling through Germany.

In 1958, Paul and Anna and Irmi and Joe became foundation members of the Rhein Donau Club.

In 1975, Joe and Irmi became foundation members of the Heimat Choir.

They were actively involved over many years in organising Club dances with entertainment. They also were involved with the early Oktoberfests held in Kalamunda and the Claremont Showgrounds.

With the Heimat Choir, Irmi attended several Sangerfests in Melbourne, Adelaide and Perth.

Irmi worked in the Club's Office in the 1970's and early 1980's, assisting the various Presidents. Her duties included typing up the Newsletter and enrolling





new members. She thoroughly enjoyed her tasks and meeting new people.

Helping in the Club's kitchen with Volker and Beatrice Theis was another enjoyable activity and soon involved her family, especially at New Years and Oktoberfest functions.

In 2003, she moved to Parkland Villas Booragoon. This was conveniently located close to the Club enabling Irmie to keep involved with the choir and later the Volksingers.

She and her family always celebrated important birthdays at the Club.

At the age of 94 Irmie moved to Meath Care Como where she spent her remaining 3 years.

Irmie passed away peacefully aged 97 on 16 December 2024.

The Club and its members have always featured prominently in Irmie's life keeping memories of her Heimat alive.

The new year started off relaxed with the Club closed in January as usual. At the beginning of February, we will open again with our beloved Summer Party.

We keep working on improving our systems and facilities to enable us to conduct the administration more efficiently and cost effectively for the benefit of our members.

The ongoing membership cards were only the first step. The second step is improving the way we are managing our memberships. We are currently working on a new Club website that will include a membership payment page. It will be up and running before our next financial year.

I would like to ask all members to embrace this change and pay their membership fees online. Furthermore, there will be options for ongoing memberships, monthly payments and new members will also be able to apply for memberships on the website.





Table Tennis Group

Hallo Rhein Donau Club!

This is Shanita Knol, currently in Fulda, Germany! I just wanted to send you, my sponsor, an update about some of the things I have been up to here. I really want to thank you all so much for this experience. It's really been life changing and something I will never forget. I have had an overall amazing time here, but these are a few of my highlights:

- I got to see snow for the first time! It's really so beautiful to see.

- My host family took me to Dresden for a weekend and the Weihnachtsmarkt there was honestly so beautiful and there were so many places to explore!

- Weihnachten! Experiencing a German Christmas, with St Nicholas, and cutting our own tree from a tree farm, and gifts on the 24th, and a typical German Christmas Dinner of duck, potato and red cabbage was really a lovely tradition to be a part of. I definitely want to take some traditions from Germany back with me to Australia.

- They also took me to Paris for 4 days, which was something I never expected to do, but the Eiffel tower was beautiful and it was lovely to learn about the history in one of the museums there, and also the Palace of Versailles.
