I would like to shout out a big thank you to Annette for putting together the successful application for a \$466,000 plus GST Community Capital Works Fund Gant from the Office of Multicultural Interests.

It is great to see that they believe in our Club and support us to make the necessary upgrades and renovations to remain a cultural hub for future generations.

We have formed a subcommittee regarding these works, and we will present our ideas and visions for the Edelweiss Hall and bar at the upcoming AGM on 25th May to our members for comments.


