

*31 October 1939 - 4 January 2026*





None returned.


But only because Brickvention isn't over yet! I'm sure they'll make their way back here... eventually.

And I've now typed LEGO so often that the word has lost all meaning to me.




Amazing Mosaic at Brickvention








## Table Tennis Group
